Garden Insecticide



HOMEMADE GARDEN INSECTICIDE

- 1 C. Liquid Cooking Oil (use a low quality oil)
- 1 T. Liquid Dish Soap
 - 1. Mix oil and dish soap together in a pint jar or other container.
 - 2. Add 2-8 teaspoons of this mixture to 1 quart of water in a spray bottle.
 - 3. Mix well with each use as it separates.
 - 4. Spray on problematic garden plants as needed.

This natural garden insecticide spray smothers insects and is effective on aphids, thrips, mites, and scale.

Low quality liquid cooking oils include vegetable, canola, corn, sunflower, or safflower oil.
